

DIRECTORS REQUESTING LEGAL OPINION

The Board of Directors can hire attorneys, other than the Attorney of Record, with specific expertise as it deems necessary

A majority vote of the Board is necessary to hire an attorney to act on behalf of the Association

For an individual director to obtain a written opinion only (not hire the attorney to act) from the Attorney of Record, the following procedure will apply:

- The request must come from three (3) Directors
- The request must be put in writing to the President of the Association and the President will forward the request to the Attorney
- The request must be posted on the bulletin board
- The opinion from the Attorney must be in writing
- The Attorneys written opinion must be posted on the bulletin board
- Only a vote of the Board can authorize the attorney to act on behalf of the Association
- All attorney contacts will be made by the following people; President, Vice President with President approval, Manager with President approval
