

## GAZEBO POLICY

In the "Criteria for establishment of temporary recreational structures", approved by the board of directors on 04/14/94 it states the following:

Gazebos may be constructed on site, providing that they have an engineering's drawing and meet all codes and park criteria.

Secondary Gazebo may be constructed on site, providing that they have an engineering's drawing and meet all codes and park criteria, from the First Day of Summer to the Last Day of Summer. All Secondary Gazebos must be tied down.

Engineering specifications sheet and drawings showing location, must be submitted for permit, and approval.

NOTE: All buildings must be tied down. Interpretation of what constitutes a "Gazebo" shall be in the sole discretion of the A.E.R.B.

### A.E.R.B. interpretation

Materials used for onsite construction, or store-bought Gazebos must have advance written approval by the A.E.R.B. No Tarps of any color for roofing, windows, shades or awnings.

- Note: Gazebo policy interpreting by the A.E.R.B is intended to mean that no tarps of any color can be used except for the original manufacturers intended use as a gazebo. Replacement tarps, side tarps or additional tarps not originally manufactured for gazebos will not be permitted.
- For A.E.R.B. purposes, a "pop-up" will be considered a canopy tent which is not approved as a permanent structure. These are for special events to block the sun and should be used as such. No canopy shall be erected for longer than 48hrs.
